TITLE: EVALUATION OF BEST VALUE CONTRACTS (USAAMCOM)

TEXT

(a) BASIS FOR AWARD: Award will be made to that offeror whose offer represents the best value to the Government considering price, past quality and delivery performance. While price is an important factor, award may be made to that offeror whose competitive strengths in the areas of past quality and delivery performance sufficiently outweigh those of the low offeror and result in a lower risk to the Government in terms of the offeror's ability to deliver, in a timely manner, a quality product.

(b) EVALUATION FACTORS:

(1) The following factors will be considered in evaluation of offers submitted in response to this solicitation.

(i) Price: The proposed price will be evaluated to determine its reasonableness.

(ii) Past Quality: The offerors prior performance in quality areas will be evaluated. In analyzing this area, the Government will consider whether any indicia of poor quality exist. Such indicia include, but are not limited to:

(A) Inability to meet first article or product verification audit requirements;

(B) Quality deficiency reports (QDRs) for items delivered and accepted by the Government. All QDRs will be examined for a period up to the past five years;

(C) Inclusion on the Defense Logistic Agency's (DLA) Contractor Alert List or other similar Government listings.

(iii) Delivery Performance: The offeror's ability to meet delivery requirements on prior contracts will be evaluated. Analysis of delivery performance will be on a unit basis.

(2) In evaluating the Past Quality and Delivery Performance factors above, primary focus and reliance will be placed on all AMCOM contracts for which delivery activity has occurred during the two year period of time prior to the closing date of the solicitation except as noted in paragraph (b)(1)(ii)(B) above. However, consideration may be given to disparities in the data between contracts for the same, similar or related NSNs and contracts for unrelated NSNs. In the absence of data on AMCOM contracts, consideration may, subject to the provisions of the clause in Section L entitled "Notice of Best Value Contracting Procedures", be given to contractor provided data on (first) other Government contracts and (second) commercial contracts over the same period of time.

(3) In addition to the information provided by the offeror in accordance with the clause in Section L entitled "Notice of the Best Value Contracting Procedures", the Government, in evaluating the Past Quality and Delivery Performance factors, may also consider information/data from other sources either within or outside of the Government.

(4) Of the three factors, Price is equal in importance to the Past Quality and Delivery Performance factors combined. Of these two factors, -1- is -2- -3-.
