TITLE: SMALL BUSINESS SUBCONTRACTING PLAN GOAL (USAAMCOM)

TEXT

(a) In consideration of the requirement in FAR 52.219-9, Small Business Subcontracting Plan, prior to award of orders in excess of \$500,000.00, the Contractor shall submit a Master Subcontracting Plan (MSP) containing the information set forth in FAR 52.219-9(d)(4) thru (d)(11). The master plan shall apply to any order requiring a plan as fully as if individually submitted. The Contractor shall submit, along with any proposal in excess of \$500,000.00, a supplement to the master plan, providing the information set forth in Far 52.219-9(d)(1) thru (d)(3). Additionally, each such submission shall contain a statement that the MSP contained in this BOA is current and applicable to the Order. If a MSP in accordance with Far 52.219-9(f) has been presented and approved by the ACO and PCO for this BOA, it shall be attached to this BOA. The ACO and/or the PCO may notify the Contractor from time to time of any required changes in the MSP required by law or regulation.

(b) Under normal circumstances, a fully acceptable subcontracting plan is required by law prior to issuance of an order which exceeds \$500,000.00. However, unpriced orders may contain a preliminary plan in accordance with FAR 19.705-5(b) (preliminary plans for this BOA shall consist of the MSP and an applicable supplement). Preliminary plans must address the requirements of FAR 19.704, and must be finalized within 90 days after award or before definitization, whichever occurs first. Failure to submit and negotiate an acceptable plan within ninety (90) calendar days after issuance of the order shall be cause for termination pursuant to the clause at FAR 52.249-8, Default (Fixed-Price Supply and Service), in Section I of this BOA.
