TITLE: SCHEDULE OF GOVERNMENT-LOANED PROPERTY (USAAMCOM)

TEXT

(a) The Government will make the Government-Loaned Property (GLP) listed below in paragraph (h) available to the contractor, upon written request to the Contracting Officer, for performance of the contract. This GLP shall be subject to the Government Property clause(s) located in Section I of this document. Government inspection and/or test property will be made available no later than thirty (30) days prior to the scheduled date for the inspection, preproduction evaluation or testing. Government inspection and/or test property shall be utilized jointly by the Government and contractor inspection personnel only, and then for the sole purpose of inspection and acceptance of completed parts, components, subassemblies and/or end items.

(b) Each offeror shall specify below the point to which GLP shall be furnished. If the offeror fails to specify a delivery point below, the delivery point shall be the address specified by the offeror in Standard Form 33 block 15A of this document. If the Government ships by rail, the property will be furnished F.O.B. the siding nearest the delivery point. If the Government ships by truck, U.S. Mail, or commercial package service, the property will be furnished F.O.B. the delivery point.

(c) The contractor shall accept delivery at the delivery point determined above. Upon acceptance, the contractor shall bear all costs incidental to any demurrage incurred and shall be responsible for any transportation of the property to the contractor's place of performance.

(d) Transportation charges to the delivery point determined above shall be a factor in the evaluation of offers. The origin shipping points shown below in paragraph (h) are for evaluation purposes only.

(e) The contractor shall check the quantity and condition of the GLP when delivered and acknowledge receipt thereof to the Property Administrator in writing within 24 hours.

(f) Upon completion of the contract, or at such earlier date as it is determined that the contractor no longer requires the GLP, the contractor shall prepare such property for commercial domestic shipment, and effect shipment thereof on a Government Bill of Lading. All costs of preparation for return shipment including but not limited to loading, blocking, and bracing the property shall be at the contractor's expense.

(g) Final payment under this document will be withheld pending notification of the Contracting Officer by the Administrative Contracting Officer, or other responsible Government Official that the GLP has been placed aboard common carrier.
