TITLE: DEMILITARIZATION (USAAMCOM)

TEXT

(a) The items called for by this contract being military items, the following provision as to the disposal of completed or partially completed parts, components, subassemblies, and end-items will apply. Property (whether title to the property is in the Government or not, and including parts, components, subassemblies, and assemblies to the extent indicated below) of the type covered by this contract for which the Contractor does not claim or is refused payment (including, but not limited to, rejects or overruns) under the provisions of this contract, but which is manufactured, fabricated, assembled or produced in connection with the manufacture, fabrication, assembly or production of the items covered by this contract, and which is manufactured, fabricated, assembled or produced on the basis of or with the aid of drawings, specifications, facilities, equipment, or material furnished or specified by the Government pursuant to this contract, will be completely destroyed or mutilated (whichever is prescribed) prior to final payment in the manner and to the extent herein below set forth in order that such property will be unusable or nonreclaimable for its original purpose, and to preclude the possibility of reconditioning such property to make it salable as implements of war: -1- (insert applicable portions of DoD 4160.21m-1)

(b) The Contractor agrees that no items demilitarized, as stated above, will be disposed of by the Contractor other than as scrap.

(c) Upon completion of production under this contract, the contractor shall certify to the Administrative Contracting Officer that demilitarization, as prescribed above, has been accomplished.

(d) The Contractor further agrees that it will include the aforesaid provisions in any subcontracts for the aforesaid items.
