TITLE: MARKINGS OF WARRANTED MATERIAL MUST BE AS FOLLOWS: (USAAMCOM)

TEXT

(1) MARKINGS:

(a) Items delivered under this contract shall be stamped or marked in accordance with MIL Standard 129, ("Marking for shipments and storage") and MIL Standard 130, ("Identification Marking of US Military Property").

(b) Each primary component delivered under this contract shall be marked as follows:

(1) A warranty identification label or plate shall be securely applied, fastened, or attached to each warranted item in a conspicuous location.

(2) The contractor shall submit drawing of the warranty label or plate identification to be used on the warranted item(s).

(3) The warranty label or plate identification shall be of an alternating blue and clear diagonal stripe background color.

(4) The plate or label shall have imprinted the following data:

(a) Warranty: The word warranty shall be in predominate bold letters.

(b) NSN: National Stock Number shall be imprinted.

(c) TB: TB shall identify the applicable technical bulletin for warranted item.

(d) EXP: EXP shall indicate the date of warranty expiration by year and month, i.e., 8612 or the specific warranty period coverage time, months, indication the start date by year and month, i.e., 8412.

(e) FSCM: The Federal Supply Code for Manufacturers (FSCM) shall be indicated, i.e., 99584.

These marking labels must be on the warranted items as well as their shipping container.
